Jesus teaches us to stand up for people who are oppressed and that we can be peacemakers in the world. How do you imagine yourself doing this?

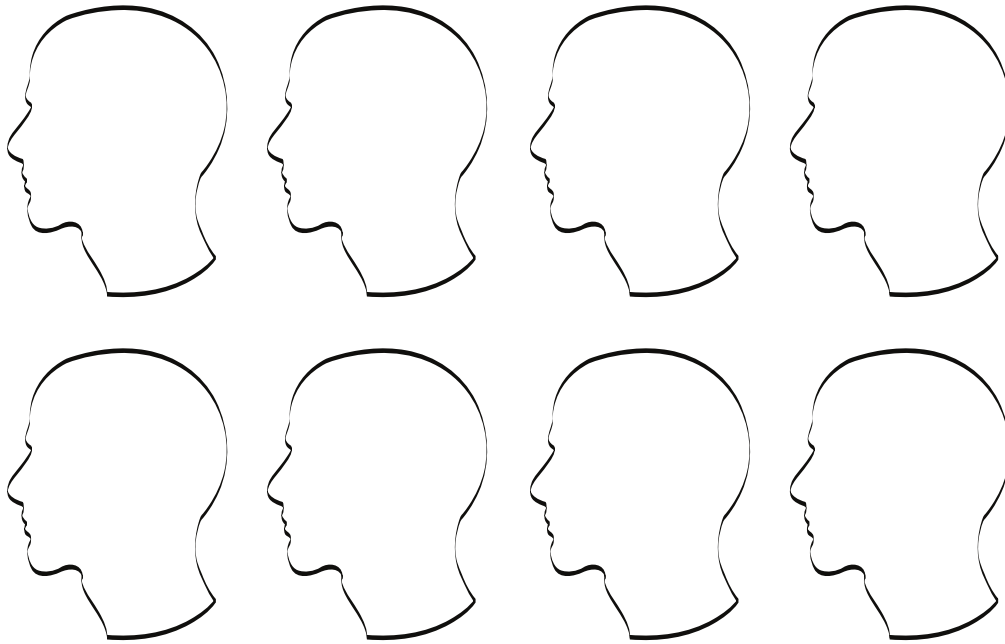
